Pick up luggage from Carousel and walk to group pick up area – pictured below. Taxi will pick up from just outside the Airport



#### **Cairns Taxi Ranks**

Each terminal has its own sheltered taxi rank at the front of each terminal building, simply follow the signage in the terminal. You cannot pre-book for fares from the Terminals however taxis are always available, and the rank is monitored 24/7 by the Cairns Taxis Booking call centre. There are free



intercom call buttons at the start of each taxi rank which connect directly to the call centre should you require additional assistance.
