

HOW YOUR DONATION BUILDS a global community:

\$1,000

\$1,000 helps a credit union member buy fruit trees to increase and diversify production leading to greater income.

\$2,500

\$2,500 supports the implementation of a financial literacy program in Kenya that encourages and educates young students to view agriculture as a means of income. The crops supply food for lunches and students sell any extra produce at a nearby market stand, providing micro-entrepreneurship experience.

\$5,000

\$5,000 covers the cost of a mortgage loan for a Haitian household to build a safe, durable, and affordable home.

\$10,000

\$10,000 covers the scholarship of four female credit union leaders to participate in the Global Women's annual workshop; equipping them with new skills, knowledge, and resources to make a measurable difference in their careers, credit unions, and community.

\$15,000

\$15,000 supports the exchange of a leadership training between an emerging credit union system and developed credit union league so participants may be better equipped to strengthen the economic security of their organizations, and consequently, their members.

\$35,000

\$35,000 covers the Young Credit Union People program and enables 100 young credit union leaders from 20+ countries to attend a free workshop and enhance their leadership skills and knowledge.

\$50,000

\$50,000 covers the cost of executing technical assistance trainings for rural credit union staff and board members worldwide so they may better serve their members.
