An organization generally must furnish filings to anyone who requests them in person or in writing. An exempt organization may meet this requirement by posting all the documents on its website or at another organizations site as part of a database of similar materials. Specific requirements must be met to meet this exception.

#### A few final reminders relating to your tax return filings:

- There are substantial penalties for failure to properly disclose and report foreign financial
  accounts and foreign activity. Please make sure you have informed us of any foreign financial
  accounts or foreign activity so that we have the necessary information to complete any required
  disclosures or filings.
- Be sure to review the returns prior to signing as you have final responsibility for all information included in the returns. Please contact us if you have any questions or concerns.
- We recommend you keep a paper or electronic copy of your tax returns permanently. Supporting documentation should be kept for a minimum of seven years based on IRS guidance.
