### SICREDI Campos Gerais

Established in 1989 to serve members of a local agricultural cooperative, SICREDI Campos Gerais has maintained a growth rate of over 25% per year since then and today serves 64,000 members. It is one of the 10 largest credit unions in the SICREDI network, with 470 employees at 25 locations across 14 municipalities and has attracted an average of 600 new members per month over the last year. We will explore the secret to achieving this phenomenal growth during our visit with SICREDI Camps Gerais.
