2025 IMPACT REPORT



In 2025, the Worldwide Foundation for Credit Unions (WFCU) continued to empower women, develop emerging leaders, support disaster-affected communities, strengthen professional capacity and advance financial inclusion in partnership with the World Council of Credit Unions (WOCCU). These achievements were made possible thanks to our global credit union network, which helped raise over **\$3 million** to drive impact across our key initiatives.

Advance Financial Inclusion with WOCCU through the Rally the Movement Campaign

Ukraine

- 430+ loans disbursed totaling \$1.2M
- 6 national policy dialogues initiated
- 10 credit unions equipped with new tools for business planning, borrower financial assessment, credit risk and liquidity management
- National credit guarantee pilot initiated



Guatemala

- 6,300+ new savings accounts opened
- 1,400+ members reached through the new last-mile methodology 67% are women
- 12 financial cooperatives trained in digital financial education tools and business plan development
- 9 financial cooperatives engaged in savings mobilization
- 2 financial cooperatives piloted the last-mile methodology
- 2 financial cooperatives launched pilot microcredit products
